

- Being focused silencing gadgets during any discussion. Attentiveness is a must.


### Activities

### Nature

**LOKAPRAJNA is a family organization with its members associated with various higher educational institutions /spiritual organizations aimed at inducing nationalistic feeling.**



## 1. Organizational Structure and various units

- There are two main sub-verticals: Sangathanik (Organization) and Shaikshanik (Academic).
- The units of the Lokaprajna are termed as Charchakendra. The type of units depend on place or subject, or front. (like Mother's, Youths, Students, Research etc)
- In each Unit, there is a Pancha shakti (5-person active team) consists of Coordinator, Co-coordinator, Mother's wing representative, Student's wing representative and an Event manager



- The roles and responsibilities of the 5-person active Team are as in the following
  - **Sanyojak (Coordinator)** : The core person for the growth of the unit.
  - **Saha Sanyojak (Co-Coordinator)**: The support of the Coordinator and should focus on the following 10- academic wing as in the following:

1. Chatra-Yuva Shakti (Students-Youth wing).
2. Matri Shakti (Mother's wing)
3. Byabastha & Samparka (Relation and event management)
4. Vijnan (Science)
5. Samaj Vijnan (Social Science) and
6. Yoga Vijnan (Health Science)
7. Sangeet (Music)
8. PrajnaVashya (Communication and publication)
9. Vimarsha (Narratives) and
10. Gobeshona (Research)



- **Byabastha / Samparka Pramukh (Event and Relation Manager)**: Responsibility of the Office, Collection and expenditure, Organizing events and maintain connectivity to Organization /Individual.
- **Matri Shakti Pramukh (Mother's Wing representative)**: to develop a cordial relationship with the Mothers-daughters of each unit and to external units also.
- **Chatra Shakti Pramukh (Students-Youth Wing representative)**: To develop relationship with a holistic approach with all four categories and host various events to boost the students with nationalism.



- Students wing has following categories:  
Usha (primary students), Uday (Class V to VIII), Unmesh (Class IX to XII) and Uttoran (College and University students)
- There are district level / zonal units (Gats) consists of number of local Units based on geographical orientations in nation's map. Previous the State level unit (Pranta /Rajya) structure are mentioned. State has three Prantas with the number of functional units below:
  - Uttarbanga (North Bengal) 6 units (viz. Maldah, Jalpaiguri etc.)
  - Madhya Banga (Central Bengal) 30 units (viz. Bardhaman, Kalyani etc..)
  - Dakshin Banga (South Bengal) 19 units

Following are their details:

### **LOKAPRAJNA Anubhab Darshan 2024 at National Institute of Technology, Durgapur**

**(March 2024):** The one day symposium at prestigious National Institute of Technology (NIT), Durgapur was jointly organized by Lokaprajna with the host on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2024 with the theme “Impact of Science and Technology on Indian Knowledge Systems”. The event was inaugurated by the Director Prof. Aravind Choubey and addressed by Dr. Parimal Acharya, Dean - Alumni affairs. Dr. Ananda Pandey, East Zone relationship representative of Prajna Pravah also addressed the same. The event was attended by over 400 people including Lokaprajna and NIT DGP In-house staffs.




The research scholars of the NIT DGP took a lead-role in hosting the event. Beside talks there were number of presentations by the Professor members of Lokaprajna which added value to the student youth members of Lokaprajna. There was book inauguration ceremony as well by the Tuhina Publication. Presence of a huge number of students beside Lokaprajna State level representatives as well as Professor, Teacher members were all present in this knowledge enriched program.



**LOKAPRAJNA Madhyabanga Anubhab Darshan 2023 at Kamarpukur and Joyrambati in two phases (July & August, 2023):**

The pilgrimage at the birth place of Shri Ramakrishna Paramhansa and Shrima Sarada Devi was hosted by Lokaprajna in two phases considering over 500 expression of interest. Over 400 ultimately turned up in both the phases, the first of which was held during 29<sup>th</sup> July to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2023. As usual, the Swamiji of Ramakrishna Mission inaugurated and provided the holy advise. Beside many educationists, Lokaprajna national Saha Sanyojak (Co-coordinator) Shri Raghunandan and erstwhile Co-coordinator Shri Srikant Katdare graced the occasion. Dr. Uday Bandyopadhyay, Director-Bose Institute Kolkata graced the valedictory session. Beside them, Shri Sambhunath Saha, Shri Samaresh



Bandyopdhyay, Dr. Suman Panigrahi, Dr. Reba Mandal and Mr. Manoranjan Hazra delivered their speech on various organizational as well as academic topics. The two days Anubhab Darshan (spiritual visit) included many famous landmarks including the childhood school (pathshala) of Paramahansa Dev, various temples, birthplace of Maa Sarada, Sarada Math, Vishalakshmi Mandir, Jagadamba Ashram etc. over 250 participants were there in this phase. The same event repeated during 26<sup>th</sup>-27<sup>th</sup> August taking into consideration the overwhelming response. Speed painting of Sri Shirsha Acharya was a remarkable show.



**LOKAPRAJNA Madhyabanga Anubhab Darshan Bankim Bhawan (1<sup>st</sup> October 2023):** The devotional visit and pilgrimage at the birth place of our National anthem “Vande Mataram darshan” took place at Bankim Bhawan at Naihati, West Bengal. The eminent speakers from Bankim Bhawan Research center graced the occasion beside the Lokaprajna Coordinators from various Units of Madhyabanga. The birthplace and the ancestral house of Bankim Chandra Chattopadhyay the creator of Vande Mataram, his childhood memory- places, home temples of Lord Shiva and Radha Govinda were visited beside the Research Institute in remembrance of Rishi Bankim Chandra. Various University speakers also added values through their gracious presence. Around 300 participants.



**LOKAPRAJNA Anubhab Darshan 2022 Narendrapur (25<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup> December, 2022):** This was held in esteemed Narendrapur Ramakrishna Mission. The event was enlightened by the kind presence of then Central Education Minister of State Dr. Subhash Sarkar who mesmerized the audience with his dissemination.



The first ever two-day (Prabas) event of LOKAPRAJNA was enlightened by the participation of around 300 intellectuals from the entire state including all three pranta -Uttarbanga, Madhyabanga and Dakshinbanga in LOKAPRAJNA terms. The enthusiastic presence of students and Mothers are notable. Pujya Swami Basabanandaji Maharaj, President NRKM mentored the entire event. The felicitation and certification of meritorious students with traditional music performance by reputed radio singers and in-house singers of Lokaprajna. The blessings of Swamijis of prestigious Narendrapur Ramakirshna Mission School are all observed.

The event was followed by a team visit at Subhashgram, the ancestral home of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose. Around 300 participants graced the occasion.



**LOKAPRAJNA Anubhab Darshan 2022 Belur Math (31<sup>st</sup> July, 2022):** This was held in Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda University, Belurmath combined all three prantas. This was preceded by a historic meeting in the previous day 30<sup>th</sup> July 2022 night by the Authority of RKMM Belurmath with delegation of LOKAPRAJNA presided by Pujya Swami Subiranandaji Maharaj, President and Pujya Swami Atmapriyanandaji Maharaj, Secretary in which The Akhil Bharatiya Sanyojak Shri. J. Nandakumar was felicitated by the Mission authority. The event was attended by a huge gathering of 400 intellectuals. The state level leadership of Sangh-Parivar were present in this meeting. Around 400 participants.



**LOKAPRAJNA Madhyabanga Anubhab Darshan 2022 Bankim Bhawan and Pranav Kanya Ashram (3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2022):** This is the first pranta event of Lokaprajna Madhyabanga after decentralization. It was organized at Pranav Kanya Ashram at Chinsurah Joraghat after morning devotional bath at river Ganges and prayer at Bankim Bhawan beside with the garlanding at the statue of Rishi Bankim Chandra Chattapadhaya. Prof. Pallab Bandyopadhaya of IIT Kharagpur was the invited speaker. The event was attended by 230 intellectuals. This is the first ever Anubhab Darshan of Madhyabanga with 225 participants.



**LOKAPRAJNA Dakshinbanga Anubhab Darshan 2022 (1<sup>st</sup> May, 2022):** The event was hosted at Rishidham, Tamruk (erstwhile Tamralipta). The key highlights of the event is a visit to historical Bargavima Temple and garlanding patriot Matangini Hazra's statue. The event was graced by the presence of Prof. V.K. Tiwari, Director, IIT Kharagpur who mesmerized the audience with his spellbound lecture. Notable delegates from academic fraternities and educationist Lokaprajna Coordinators of various levels viz. State, Pranta and Gata especially the matrishakti presence was observable. Around 300 participants.



**LOKAPRAJNA Paschimbanga Anubhab Darshan 2022 RathindraMancha Jorashanko (2<sup>nd</sup> January, 2022):** Lokaprajna Anubhab Darshan comprising all three prantas Madhyabnaga, Dakshinbanga and Uttarbanga held at Rathindramancha under administrative control of Rabindrabharati University at Jorashanko that recalls memory of Kaviguru Rabindranath Tagore. The theme of this event was “Swadhinata to Swatantrata” (from independence to liberty). Felicitating students and graceful presence of renowned academicians are key highlights beside national stalwarts of Prajna Pravah, the intellectual forum. The event was presided by Pujya Swami Jnanalokanandaji Maharaj, RKM and National Coordinator of Prajna Pravah, Shri J. Nandakumarji’s and Acharya Sri Bandhu Gaurav Brahmachari of Gouriya Math’s gracious presence. Revered Sangha Parivar stalwarts Shri B. Das Roy and Shri S.P. Goswami were also enriched the audience with speeches. Over 400 participants.




**LOKAPRAJNA Paschimbanga Anubhab Darshan 2021 tripartite at Kalighat, Netaji and Bharatkeshari ancestral home (2<sup>nd</sup> February/ March 2021):** Lokaprajna Anubhab Darshan comprising all both the pranta Uttar and Dakshin happened through spiritual visit in two phases respectively on 2<sup>nd</sup> February and 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2021. Three places were taken into consideration viz. Kalighat Matri Darshan which happens to be one of the divine 51 sati piths in the nation, followed by visit at the ancestral home of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose and finally the house of Sir Asutosh Mukherjee, renowned as Bengal Tiger in which his son Martyr Bharat Keshari Shyama Prasad Mukhopadhyay has born. The top functionaries of state level of Lokaprajna were all present beside teacher/ professors members. The Books of Mr. Sandip Sinha and others were unfolded. The students were excited in having a physical visit at the place of famous patriots/ nationalist/ martyrs of the stature of Shyama Prasad and especially Netaji at 5 Elgin road. The address by a successor from the Bose family was key attraction.



The puja was performed at the divine Satipith Kalighat Temple of Goddess Ma Kali. The group lunch was held at the origin and birthplace of Shyama prasad.

**LOKAPRAJNA Anubhab Darshan 2020 at Bharat Sevashram Sangha International headquarter at Ballygunge (15<sup>th</sup> March 2020):** The holy place of Jugacharya Swami Pranavananda ji Maharaj, the founder of Bharat Sevashram Sangha. This is last largest event of before the dreaded pandemic that troubles the entire world during 2020-21. It was organized on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2020, the time when all Universities /Institutions were getting closed and converted to online mode later due massive COVID 19 death rate. Ignoring this life threat, 55 brave members of Lokaprajna made their presence felt by singing national anthem and observing and paying respect to Jugacharya who originated from Bajitpur, now became part of Bangladesh post independence. The mind blowing religious and full of patriotism speech by Swamijis of Bhrata Sevashram Sangha was the take away.



**LOKAPRAJNA Anubhab Darshan 2020 at Swami Vivekananda ancestral home (2<sup>nd</sup> February 2020):** The divine place filled with remembrance of childhood nostalgia of Swami Vivekananda under the administrative control of Ramkrishna Math o Mission was conducted on second February 2020. The Lokaprajna audience was mesmerized by the divine speech of Swami Jnanalokananda, the monk and mentor of the ancestral home of Swamiji (called 'Bile' in childhood). Following Lokaprajna event practices the blessings of the Swamiji's, Book inauguration, National anthem, patriotic music, speeches all took place beside regular Puja timing of the holy place and a visit at the museum and book store filled with childhood remembrance of Swamiji. Over 200 participants from across the state graced the occasion.


## 6. Conclusion
